Here's what we talked about today.

God, the creator of the world, loves us. **Wow!** (Ephesians 2:4) But all people have sinned and our sins separate us from God. **Uh-oh.** (Romans 3:23)

God sent Jesus to make us right with Him again. **Yes!** Jesus died on the cross, taking the punishment for our sin, then He rose from the dead. When we say **Yes!** to Jesus, God freely accepts us and takes away our sin. (Colossians 1:21-22)

Saying **Yes!** to Jesus gives us eternal life and peace. **Ahhh.** (John 3:16-17; Romans 5:1)

MEMORY VERSE



Who can memorize this verse first?
