Saul, also known as Paul, hated Christians and tried to hurt them. Saul planned to travel to Damascus to arrest Christians living there. On the road, a bright light surrounded Paul. Jesus spoke to Paul after which he was blind. Ananias found Paul and restored his sight. Paul immediately began to preach about Jesus, saying, "Jesus is the Son of God!"

Jesus changed Paul inside and out. Once an enemy of Christians, Jesus called Paul to spend the rest of his life telling people the Gospel and leading them to put their faith in Jesus.
