Immutable: unchanging over time or unable to be changed.

Gods immutability refers to Gods changeless being.

1. God is unchanging in His character

Psalm 102:27 "You remain the same, and your years will never come to an end."

Psalm 103:17 "From everlasting to everlasting, the Lords love is with those who fear him."

Holy: Set apart, hallow, sanctify.
